Go Beyond The Average Small Tank Inspector, Be More!!!

Many tank owners believe that since The EPA's SPCC Program makes little mention of the tank's "material of construction" then perhaps FRP and Plastic tanks are exempt from tank integrity inspection. Wrong!!

Not listing a type of storage unit such as FRP and Plastic tanks in the EPA's SPCC, does not automatically exempt them and yes they must be inspected.

Other requirements for inspection come from OSHA, NFPA, State and local jurisdictions.
